RULES

This event will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2013-2016* (RRS) and this Notice of Race, except as modified in the Sailing Instructions and any appendices.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The regatta is open to all boats of the Optimist, 420, Sturdee Cat, and Annisquam Fish class. There will be two divisions of the Optimist fleet: Green and Championship. Optis will declare their division at registration. All boats may enter by completing a registration form, accessible on the website, and returning it to the Race Office by noon on the day of the event. There is no entry fee.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

SCORING

The Low Point Scoring System will be used. One race will constitute a regatta. If more than 5 races are sailed, a boat's worst score will be discarded.

PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded as follows: Fish: 1st place; Sturdee Cats: 1st and 2nd places; all other classes: minimum 1st, 2nd, and 3rd; up to 5th depending on fleet size.
